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Concepts and definition

Concept	Definition
Acces	The availability of certain services, resources and infrastructure. Affordability, acceptability or appropriatebness are not taken into consideration in the profiling
Community	For the purpose of profiling, is deifined as a group of people who usually live tog ether (geographical location), have a common nasara (nakamal) for a meeting place to discuss or decide on affairs relating to the community wellbeing. The community can have a council, common goals, action plan, by-laws etc
Community profile	is a description of the needs of a community that is defined, or defines itself, as a community, and the resources that exist within that community, carried out with the active involvement of the community itself, for the purpose of developing an action plan or other means of improving the quality of life of the community.
Household	<p>A household is defined as “Those persons who usually eat together and share the work of preparing the food and/or the cost of work of providing it”. A household can also be an individual person without combining with other persons. A household may be found in a variety of forms. It may spread over more than one building. Members of a family may sleep in two or even more buildings but share one place to cook and eat.</p> <p>The household size in this case refers to the average measure obtained by dividing the number of people in households of a given area by the total number of households in the area</p>

The community profiling serves as a vital tool in unveiling many key underlying layers of our societies, offering insights into development progress in terms of service delivery, economy, infrastructure, cultures, values, and challenges that defines any community.

In 2020, Sanma provincial government took a step to conduct a community profile for its 11 local area councils, to stock take and provide necessary updates on the community needs, goals and visions. Thematic areas were identified and aligned to provincial government plans and objectives. The systematic approach through design, support and implementation with the help of its key stakeholder, allows the proper profiling to be conducted in the last quarter of 2023.

The results presented here reflects the concerted effort to work with the community, to conduct interviews targeting community leaders. Such information is very rich and often unheard, given the methodology, and adding value to existing data that

Methodology

The community profiling is a process that involves various and rigorous stages from design to data analysis to ensure quality data is collected and can be validated with other sources. As much as possible, the processes outlined in the general statistics business process model¹ are adhered to, to ensure that data is reliable and that represents the entire community. Although the unit of collection in this case is community, analysis is conducted for Area council level, the lowest government administrative level. This is to allow the results to be compared to other sources that may be available at that level. Unlike other sources whether the denominators are the total population or households, the denominator in this instance is the number of communities in the area council.

The stages of the community profile



Data collection including logistical arrangements were trialed, reviewed for over a year. What has become clear is that data captured using mobile devices is the way forward for obvious reasons. This has come with relevant training and configurations before the field operation, Kobo Collect in this case was used for collection

The respondents to the profiling are mostly community leaders such as chiefs, church leaders, women leaders with members to may have active roles in representing community on other sectors such as youth, health, environment and other. There is the assumption that community leaders will have better understanding of their community therefore will be in a better position to provide useful information on community characteristics with regards to its access to services, availability of resources, needs and priorities of the community.

Given the challenges to provide estimates on the population and household numbers, the 2020 census of population and housing is used as the source of the 2 indicators. This also gives the opportunity in future to add other administrative sources to the profile and allowing the methodology to expand beyond community interviews.

- ~ Understand community needs and resource strengths, the access (the haves, and have nots)
- ~ Compliment and add value to existing community level data and information (Bureau of Statistics, Civil Registration and Identity Management, etc)
- ~ Empower communities to participate in decision making process
- ~ Strengthen networking and collaboration between communities and AAs
- ~ Build capacities for AAs and CLOs in terms of conducting research and reporting

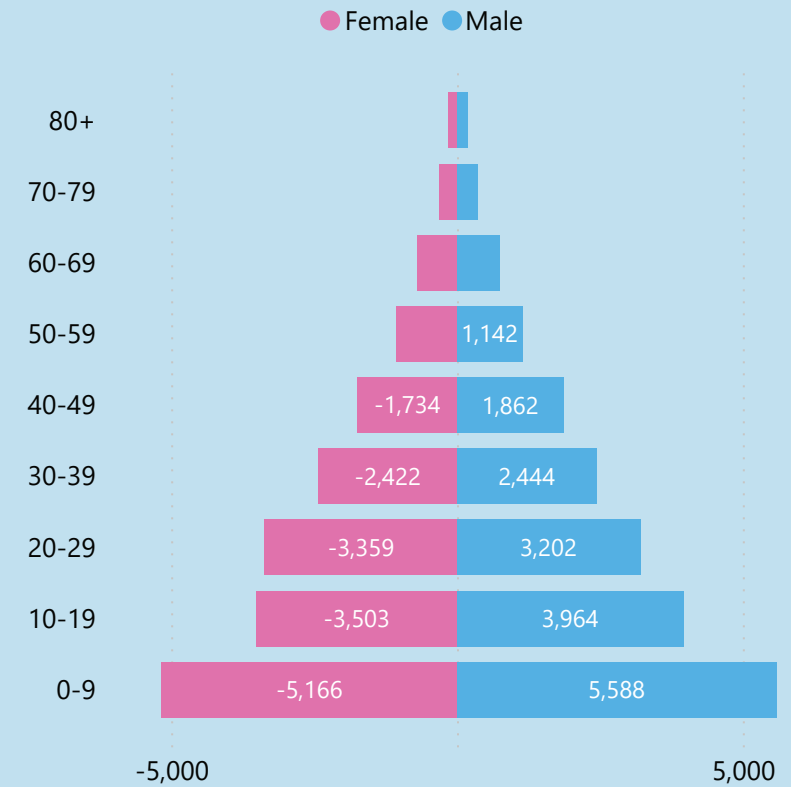


Population distribution by sex

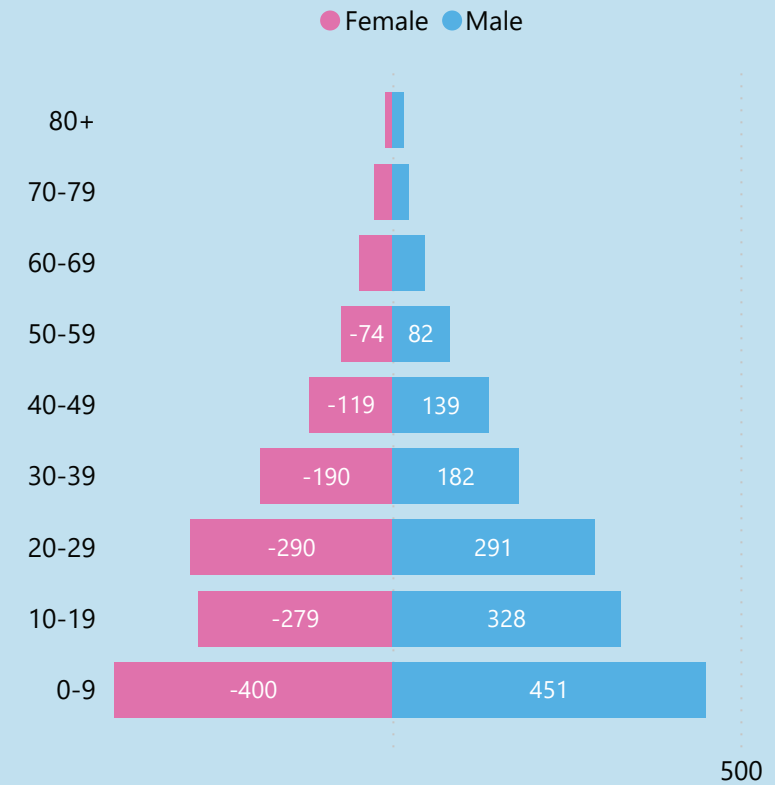


Population distribution by sex

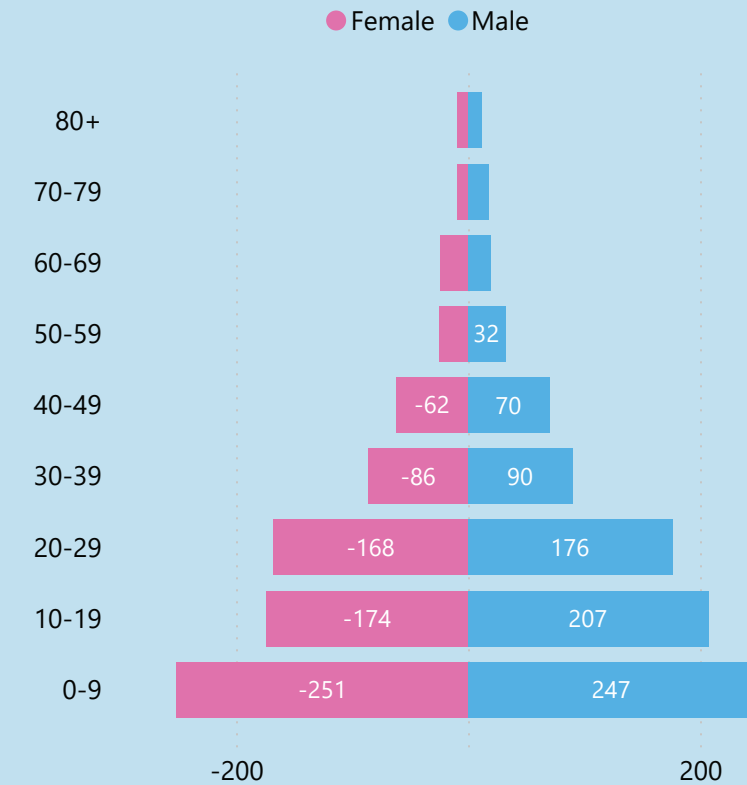


Population distribution by sex

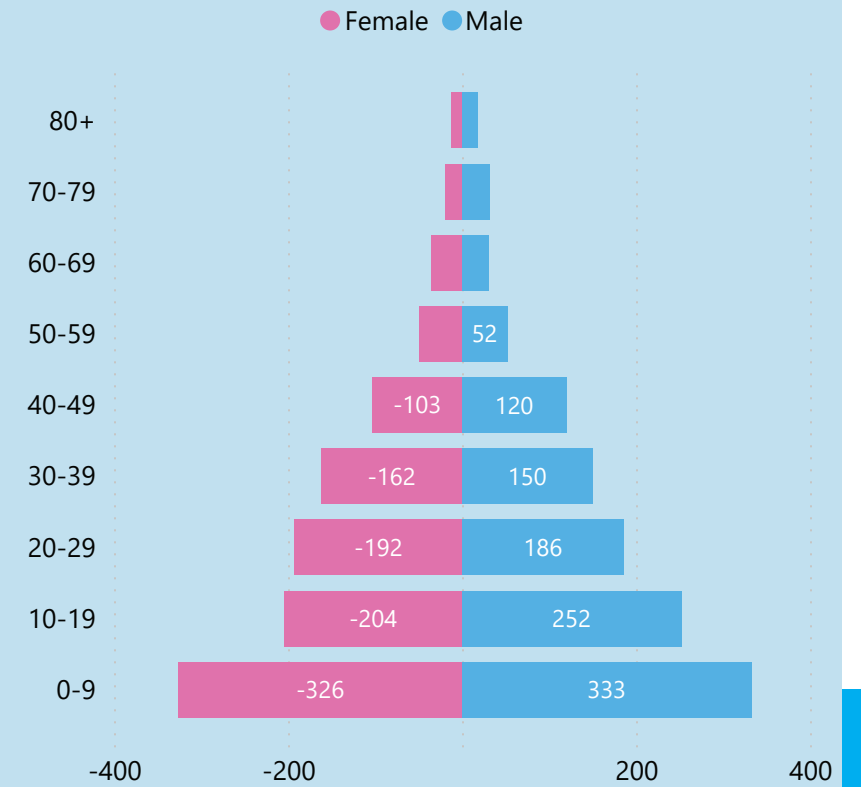


Population distribution by sex
